2010 BMEF GRANTS

The BMEF awarded \$50,420 for grants in 2010 to enhance and enrich a variety of curricular areas at all of the Briarcliff Schools. Grants in 2010 include:

► Science/Technology

A Solar Panel Monitoring Device for BHS and BMS, Probeware and Sensors for Todd and BMS Science Programs, Growlab Desktop Gardens for Kindergarteners, Smart Document Cameras for 4th and 5th Grade Science.

► English/Language Arts/Reading

Digital Video Frames for all three school's Libraries to show student book recommendations and events, Video Camcorders for use of all Todd staff, a Flip Camcorder for ELA use in 1st grade classroom, an Airliner Slate for remote use of the SmartBoard in the BHS Library, Kindergarten Sign Language Program.

► Math

Training and Materials for the Singapore Math Program, an innovative Model Drawing Method that brings math word problems to life for students in grades K-6.

► The Arts

Wet Clay Materials to use existing kiln and glazes at Todd, Smartmusic Scholarships for 5th grade students in need, Funding in partnership with PTA and BOCES for 6th graders to create a Ceramic Tile Mural for Outdoor Classroom, Art Display Units for BHS, a SmartBoard for HS Orchestra Room

► Social/Cultural Development

The David Levine - School of Belonging Program Todd and BMS to promote empathy and social and cultural building, Freedom from Chemical Dependency Workshops in partnership with the PTA for 8th grade students, "Organizing the Disorganized Child" Training Program for BMS to promote organizational skills, The Varsity Athletes Against Substance Abuse Program, Cheerleading Mats funded in conjunction with the BHS Athletic Department.
